## Festival Reports

Festival reports can include festivals in the surrounding states if a good number of Texas dancers attend the festival or if clinicians are TRDTA members.

### Harvest Holiday Festival

November 26-28, 2021 – Dallas, Texas

This year, Harvest Holiday celebrated their 61st year with Randy and Marie Preskitt as the featured clinicians. They taught two new choreography, a Phase 4 Foxtrot, *Hallalujah Foxtrot*, and a Phase 5+1 Rumba, *Only One Time*. The Foxtrot plus 1 figure was a Check and Weave, and the Rumba plus 1 figure was Three Alemanas. Randy and Marie did an excellent clinic on the two dances. They particularly spent a lot of time working on improving the dancer's figure execution in Foxtrot. Feedback from the dancers was very appreciative of those figure clinics.

Harvest Holiday Festival happens every year over the long Thanksgiving holiday weekend and is held at the Sokol Ballroom near Walnut Hill and Greenville in Dallas. Previous years have included additional dancing Monday through Wednesday along with teaches. Those days were eliminated this year due to the lingering effects from shutdowns which has reduced the number of dancers. A decision has not yet been made as to whether Harvest Holiday will schedule those additional dancing and teaching days next year.

### CenTex Festival

October 8-10, 2021 – La Grange, Texas

This Phase 3-5 festival featuring Deb and Tim Vogt was very well attended this year with 34 dancing couples on the floor. Deb and Tim introduced their new choreography, Sugarcane, a Phase 5+1 Waltz. They also taught Small Planes, a Phase 4+2 West Coast Swing by Bill and Carol Goss which had just been introduced at the Palm Springs weekend two weeks before. It was so nice to have new dance choreography for the festival. Deb and Tim did a fabulous job teaching and many of the dancers commented how very much they liked the teaching and figure clinic during the teach.

Everyone attending had a great time and really appreciated getting back to dancing again. Next year on October 7-9, 2022, CenTex will feature Randy and Marie Preskitt.
