I think we would all agree that La Grange is a very central area for the three major cities, Dallas, San Antonio/Austin and Houston. Most people who attend live in this triangle. We had a total of 60 dancers this year.

The food was excellent and plentiful. We even managed to get bottled water this year which we know everyone appreciated. The teaches were considered hard enough for most but not too hard. The members voted to initiate a nominal annual membership fee of \$10.00 per teaching unit, due July 1st of each year. Hopefully, this will help offset the cost of the hall a little without having to raise the cost of the dance. This is one of the most affordable dance weekends in our activity.

The board also agreed to have a one-time waiver for new (less than a year) dancers to attend the TRDTA dance for free. This will encourage students to get their feet wet and try a weekend of dance and fellowship. We hope the teachers will encourage all their students to attend next year.

Even though this year's dance is just behind us, it is not too early to begin thinking about next year's festival. We would love to hear from any cuers who may be considering doing a teach at the dance.
