Everything then matches in the compiled lists of dances taught from everyone and for dances taught in beginner lessons. Then, it's easier for both Tammy and JL to use these lists to help put together their dance voting list for Centex and TRDTA South. Please, please, don't use tabs or multiple spaces, or color your text. Here's the most appreciated format:

Dance name, phase level, rhythm, and choreographer's last name

For example – Sam's New Pants, 4 FT, Finch

Bolero – is really BL, not Body Odor (that's how I remember it's not BO), and Foxtrot is FT, not FX for Fox . . . and I think you get the picture. Thank you so much for helping out.

Then the next figure is Back, Back/Lock Back. The first "back" is the last step of the Progressive Chasse Right. The dancers had no trouble with the change in cue terms once they had the explanation, however, we have chosen to document that option in the cuesheet to match Roundalab preferred cue terms.
