Roundalab Mini-Lab Report

In November, 2018, Louisiana Round Dance Association (LRDA) applied to Roundalab for a Mini-Lab to be held in Bossier City, Louisiana in September, 2019. A Mini-Lab is a condensed version of the Roundalab convention. It is designed to provide education to round dance leaders and prospective leaders. Our request was approved in May 2019, for our preferred dates of September 18 through 20, the days immediately preceding our annual LRDA Weekend, phase 2-4 festival.

John and Karen Herr of Larkspur, Colorado were the clinicians who agreed to do the Mini-Lab. They have been members of Roundalab for over 30 years. They shared with us a wealth of information and experience not only of their own, but from many other Roundalab professionals in areas such as the art of cueing, preferred cueing terms, music, dancing, choreography, sound, stage presence, working with callers, marketing, and technology. One favorite part was adding fun to your cueing. There was a LOT packed into just a few days, including information about becoming a member of Roundalab and the advantages of doing so.

There were 17 teaching units which included cuers, potential cuers, and some with or without their partner who attended the Mini-Lab. There were people at the Mini-Lab from five states, including five Texas cuers from San Antonio, Longview, Arlington, Richardson, and Frisco. Other states represented were Louisiana, Arkansas, North Carolina, and Colorado.

A great time was had by all. New friendships were made; older friendships were strengthened. It was only for a few days, but there was much networking, learning, and bonding.
