November 24-26, 2023 – Dallas, Texas

They taught their two new choreographies, a Phase 6 Waltz, Baking Day, by Tom Hicks, a Phase 4 Rumba of their own, You've Got a Friend, and then a special treat, taught a third dance, their Phase 5 WCS, Don't Ever that they originally introduced at ICBDA in Winston-Salem. The dancers thoroughly enjoyed Pamela and Jeff's teaching and the new dances.

Randy and Marie Preskitt will be the featured clinicians for the Harvest Holiday festival next year. At the same time, Harvest Holiday is pleased to announce both a change in venue and a change in dates. The Harvest Holiday members are looking forward to using Swingtime Center in Fort Worth with its 6000 square foot floating wood floor next year. Due to the impossibility of using Swingtime Center over the Thanksgiving weekend, Harvest Holiday negotiated with several square dance clubs to free up the second weekend in December going forward for the Harvest Holiday festival.
